Dr Hans Blix, Swedish diplomat, international human rights lawyer, weapons inspector and disarmament campaigner, is the 2007 Sydney Peace Prize recipient. The citation reads, "Hans Blix, for principled and courageous opposition to proponents of war in Iraq, for life long advocacy of humanitarian law and non violence and for leadership of disarmament programs to rid the world of weapons of terror".

Dr Blix will deliver the City of Sydney Peace Prize Lecture on November 7th and will receive the 2007 Peace Prize at the University of Sydney on November 8th.

Now in its tenth anniversary year, Australia's only international award for peace has a significant record of promoting dialogue about peace with justice. Previous recipients of this prize have included, the inaugural recipient and last year's Nobel Peace Prize winner Professor Muhammad; Nobel Laureate Archbishop Emeritus Desmond Tutu; the former Governor General of Australia Sir William Deane; and, celebrated author and human rights campaigner Arundhati Roy.

Beyond its award of the Sydney Peace Prize, the Foundation promotes corporate sector, community and media involvement in projects concerned with human rights and non-violence. It funds community development, school's peace initiatives and scholarships for students from the world's poorest nations.
